

CORRIDORS - DEFINED

"A transportation <u>corridor</u> is defined as "a combination of discrete, adjacent surface transportation networks (e.g., freeway, arterial, rail networks) that link the same major origins and destinations. It is <u>defined</u> <u>operationally</u> rather than geographically or organizationally.






