Kentucky's Exports



- Exported over \$20 billion of goods during 2011, ranking 20th highest in total exports
- 2011 exports add approximately \$5.3 billion to the Commonwealth's direct state gross domestic product (GDP), creating 48,700 direct jobs
- Major export markets include Canada, United Kingdom, Mexico, Japan, and Brazil
- Top four exported goods include:
 - Transportation equipment
 - Chemicals
 - Machinery (non-electrical)
 - Computers and electronic products
